

Stroke Risks

Reduce Your Risk Factors for Stroke

While there are certain risk factors you can't control, such as family history or age, you have the power to greatly reduce your risk of stroke.

- Control your blood pressure.
- If you smoke, quit.
- Manage your diabetes.
- Maintain a healthy weight.
- Eat a healthy diet.
- Exercise regularly.
- Limit alcohol consumption.
- Get regular checkups.

Who Is at Greater Risk for Stroke?

- People age 55 or older.
- Women.
- African Americans.
- People with a close relative who've had a stroke.
- People who have had a stroke, transient ischemic attack or heart attack.
